

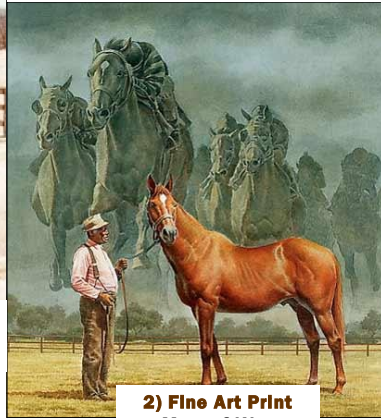
Collectible Fred Stone Prints For Sale

Proceeds from this donated collection go to the non-profit organization for the benefit of Oregon Horsemen.

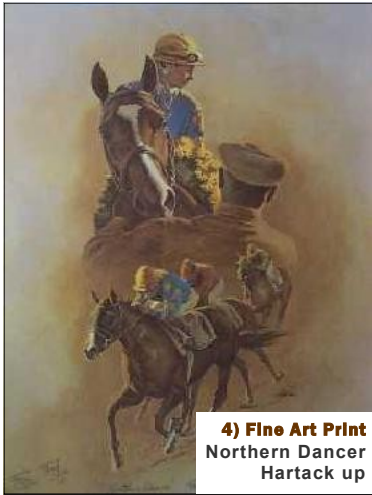

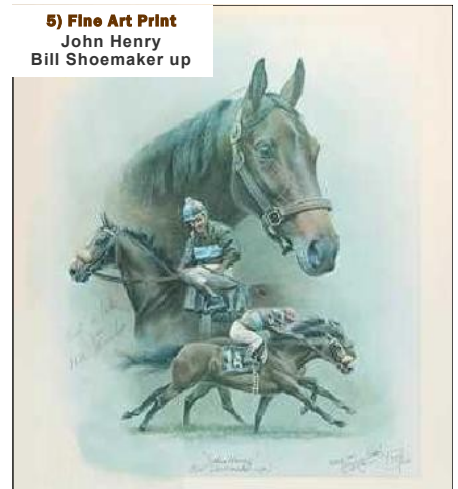
